





BUDGET AND SPENDING

An FRC team's budget can range from very small for new teams to rather large for veteran or highly competitive teams. Key expenses include mandatory FIRST registration fees (which can exceed \$15,000 alone for multiple events each year) and costs for robot parts, tools, travel, and lodging. Sponsorship is crucial, and teams fundraise and apply for grants to cover these costs.
